1. Who can attend our BIM/AEC Online Hackathon?

AEC Professionals, VDC/BIM Managers, Facilities Managers, GIS Specialists, Tech Developers, BIM nerds, Game Programmers, UX/UI Designers, rebels that code, and anyone in between! Who said hackathons are for developers only? If you are over 18 years old and are somehow involved in the built environment. Get ready to have fun! Come with your industry experience and the problems you want to solve.

2. How much does it cost?

It is absolutely free! There is no entry fee :)

3. What size are the teams? What happens if I don't have a team?

All teams must have a minimum of 2 participants and a maximum of 5. You can start the event already with a team or you can form your team in the #ideas Slack channel. You have two ways of doing this: By presenting an idea and encouraging other participants to join you or, if you don't have an idea, by joining the one that you find the most interesting. Remember: once you have your team and your idea, you can start hacking!

4. What about the different time zones?

Since this is an online event and we have participants from all over the world, there might be teams with hackers in different time zones. In the hacking period, this should not be a problem, each team can figure out a hacking workflow that works for them. The only requirement is that at least one member of the team is live during the presentation of the projects on July 27th at 1 pm PST, to pitch the solution to the judges in English. Please keep in mind to guarantee good internet access to anticipate any connectivity issues on the day of the presentations.

5. Is there any requirement for the presentation of the projects?

All teams must present their hacking solutions on July 27th at 1 pm PST. Each team will have 3 minutes to pitch the project, and after that, the panel of judges will have 5 minutes to pose any questions they might have about the project. As long as you don't go over the time limit, the ideas can be presented however you like: in a video, using a slides presentation or some original gaming platform ; Don't be afraid to get creative!

6. Will there be prizes?

Well, it's not about winning—it's about learning and making friends (so everyone's a winner!). If you're thinking, "that's adorable...but really," then we've got you covered too. A panel of professional judges will select the top three hacks, one for each of the following categories:

- Best Overall Project



- **Most Creative Project**
- **Impact:** The potential value and impact the solution would have in the BIM world
